DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

HB 4043	Prohibits interfering with animal cruelty investigation; clarifies crimes of animal abuse and neglect; increases potential penalties for animal abuse and neglect. Passed.
HB 4132	Requires state agencies to develop an adaptive management and social monitoring program to support Oregon's marine reserves, which will help protect the animals living there. Passed.
HB 4145	Prohibits the creation, distribution and possession of visual recordings of aggravated animal abuse. Passed.
