DESCRIPTION OF BILLS									
HB4128	Restricts possession of certain species of animals to limit spread of zoonotic diseases; prohibits sale of live wildlife for consumption ("wet markets"). Likely to help reduce confinement of live wildlife. Passed.								
SB 1504	Prohibits gambling on greyhound races through Oregon wagering system if greyhound racing is illegal in gambler's location; requires regular report on bets taken in Oregon for greyhound racing; prohibits license for greyhound race meets in Oregon. Passed.
