DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

HB2625	Allows authorities to seek ownership of all animals seized in animal crime
HB2732	Allows private citizen to break into vehicle to rescue child or domestic
HB2883	Increases penalties for guides and outfitters who violate wildlife laws.
HB3177	Allows seizure of chicks and hens (along with roosters) in action to enforce
HB3283	Increases penalty for animal neglect; increases protection for pet parrots.
