DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

HB2625	Allows authorities to seek ownership of all animals seized in animal crime case. Humane vote = yes.
HB2732	Allows private citizen to break into vehicle to rescue child or domestic animal. Humane vote = yes.
HB2883	Increases penalties for guides and outfitters who violate wildlife laws. Humane vote = yes.
HB3177	Allows seizure of chicks and hens (along with roosters) in action to enforce cockfighting ban. Humane vote = yes.

HB3283	Increases penalty for animal neglect; increases protection for pet parrots. Humane vote = yes. (Vote before conference committee amendments.)
