DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

HB 2978	Improves state programs to promote safe highway crossings for wildlife.
HB 3020	Prohibits betting on dog racing through Oregon-licensed businesses, regardless of where the race takes place.
HB 3932	Prohibits recreational and commercial hunting and trapping of beavers on public land in or adjacent to waterways with poor water quality.
SB 181	Would have prohibited certain medically unnecessary laboratory research on dogs and cats. The bill passed the Senate but did not receive a vote in the House.
Sponsor	Sponsorship of animal-related legislation. Sponsorship of good bills scored positive; sponsorship of bad bills scored negative. Neutral means no relevant sponsorship or sponsorship of both good and bad bills.
