DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

HB2728	Would have banned coyote-killing contests. Passed House; did not receive a vote in Senate. Humane vote: "Yes"
HB3167	Would have continued "predator damage control districts" to raise money for killing wildlife deemed a threat to private property. Passed House; did not receive a vote in Senate. Humane Vote: "No"
Sponsor	Chief or co-sponsor of key animal-related legislation (good or bad).
