DESCRIPTION OF BILLS

[HB 4134](#)

Increased the transient lodging tax to help fund wildlife conservation programs by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, including the state's "wildlife action plan" and a program to promote coexistence with wildlife.

[HB 4034](#)

Eased regulatory requirements and fines for animal rescues while still ensuring protections for animal welfare.
