DESCRIPTION OF BILLS											
HB 2977	Would have increased the transient lodging tax to help fund wildlife conservation programs by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, including a program to promote wildlife coexistence. Passed House but did not receive a Senate vote.										
HB 2978	Improves state programs to promote safe highway crossings for wildlife.										
HB 3020	Prohibits betting on dog racing through Oregon-licensed businesses, regardless of where the race takes place.										
HB 3932	Prohibits recreational and commercial hunting and trapping of beavers on public land in or adjacent to waterways with poor water quality.										
Sponsor	Sponsorship of animal-related legislation. Sponsorship of good bills scored positive; sponsorship of bad bills scored negative. Neutral means no relevant sponsorship or sponsorship of both good and bad bills.										
Other	Actions and positions not reflected in floor votes or bill sponsorship (vote in committee, significant advocacy, etc.). Additional information on request.
